The Institute "Faculty of Architecture and Planning-AKTU", Primarily a faculty of Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam Technical University Lucknow, is set on a 6-acre site and is a short walk from Hazratganj's city centre. It was founded in 1911 as a branch of the Government College of Arts and Crafts and is one of the country's oldest. The institution split from the Government College of Arts and Crafts in 1976, adopting the name 'Government School of Architecture.' It was later renamed 'Government College of Architecture, Lucknow' (popularly known as GCA, Lucknow) in 1980, when it gained the status of constituent college of Lucknow University.

Until the 1999-2000 academic year, the College, which was part of Lucknow University's 'Faculty of Architecture & Planning,' offered a 5-year degree programme culminating to the award of a Bachelor's degree in Architecture (B. Arch). As of the academic year 2000-2001, it was affiliated with the newly founded 'U.P. Technical University, Lucknow' for all academic affairs, in accordance with a government decision that applied to all other technical institutes in the state.

- GEO-INFORMATICS LABORATORY TRAINING The laboratory training was conducted in accordance with the studio exercise. Introduction and analysis of spatial data and attribute data; satellite images as input to GIS and collection and presentation of baseline information.
- **OUTLINE DEVELOPMENT PLAN –** The studio exercise focused on the planning, development and design aspects. The exercise pertains to emerging metropolitan city of Lucknow and ranges from presentation of sustainable development plans to sector specific themes pertaining to tourism, ODOP etc. The studio enabled the students to develop an approach/framework for the planning. A field based database is generated that is analyzed and the plan and strategies were formulated.

To study relevance of disaster management in development of environment.


