## about college

The Institute "Faculty of Architecture and Planning-AKTU", primarily a faculty of Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam Technical University Lucknow, is set on a 6-acre site and is a short walk from Hazratganj's city centre. It was founded in 1911 as a branch of the Government College of Arts and Crafts and is one of the country's oldest. The institution split from the Government College of Arts and Crafts in 1976, adopting the name "Government School of Architecture." It was later renamed "Government College of Architecture, Lucknow" (popularly known as GCA, Lucknow) in 1980, when it gained the status of a constituent college of Lucknow University.

Until the 1999-2000 academic year, the college, which was part of Lucknow University's "Faculty of Architecture & Planning," offered a 5-year degree programme culminating in the award of a Bachelor's degree in Architecture (B. Arch). As of the academic year 2000-2001, it was affiliated with the newly founded "U.P. Technical University, Lucknow" for all academic affairs, in accordance with a government decision that applied to all other technical institutes in the state.

### **Placement Procedure**

- 1. Placement Cell which includes the Professor-In-Charge (PIC), faculty coordinators and student representatives, sends invitation to the companies/organizations along with the relevant information.
- 2. The interested recruiters fill a Job Notification Form (JNF) containing all the required details about the placement. They may send the required information to the PIC at his email address or through post at the Placement office.
- 3. Any recruiter interested in delivering a Pre-Placement Talk (PPT) may send the request to the PIC along with the relevant details.
- 4. The JNF is made available to the students along with the relevant details.
- 5. Interested students may apply for the recruitment process of a company through online or written applications.
- 6. In consultation with the company Placement Cell allots a particular date to the company for the campus interviews.
- 7. Companies can go through the resumes of the interested students to shortlist the students.
- 8. The recruiters visit the campus at the allotted date(s) to conduct the test(s) and/or interview(s) as per the recruitment process.
- 9. The recruiters are required to declare the final list of the selected students on the date of interview(s).

# facilities for recruiters

The Recruiters are provided with all the required facilities for the placement process, as mentioned below –

- The computer and internet facilities are available for online test.
- Any recruiter interested in delivering a Pre-Placement will be provided with an auditorium and other required facilities.
- Fully furnished, air conditioned rooms will be available for group discussion and personal interviews.
- Telephonic and Video conferencing facilities will be provided through Zoom, Skype, Google meet and Microsoft team.
